



MARKETPLACE QR CODE CAPABILITY

What is a QR Code?

A QR Code (displayed above) is a machine-readable code consisting of an array of black and white squares, typically used for storing URLs or other information, for reading by the camera on a smartphone.

How could I use a QR Code?

Marketplace has the capability to create a QR Code for a specific Store or Product. The code can be created in a variety of file types to be saved and used as you would any other saved image. You can print the code on flyers, send it in an email to your customers, or have it displayed in your department for customers who come in-person to pay. Marketplace is mobile friendly, making it easy to navigate on a phone.

Could this eliminate accepting cash?

Possibly! A department could display a QR Code on a sign in their office to direct customers to pay online via their cell phone while still in-person at the department.

Go ahead, try it!
Open the camera on
your cell phone and
scan the QR Code

The code is created to
bring you directly to the
department's store or
product (here, a test
store)

Shop through the store
and add products to the
cart

Proceed to checkout.
Complete required fields
and continue to
Payment Method

Click in the Credit Card
Number field. Select
"Scan new card". Line
the frame with your
credit card and the
number and expiration
will auto-fill - It's that
easy!
